The workings of this profound documentary is simple in appearance: the Korean director returns to Seoul regularly to visit her family, and during each of her visits, she turns her walks and encounters into videos as if writing in a personal diary. In such an abundance of seemingly trivial and accidental images, she draws a video montage, weaving together ruminations inspired by the city, by art, and by memory. In the book version, Korean and French comprise the main text, while English (the original language of the film) is affixed at the end of the book along with QR codes that play the original voice over of the film
